

• In his Christmas Day message from the Vatican, Pope Francis said the world is suffering from a "famine of peace". He called for an end to wars and condemning what he said was the use of "food as a weapon" of war. These words and his prayer should be on all our lips and hearts as we head into the New Year. So we pray, Lord, may it be so.

CONCERNS OF THE CHURCH

- Areas of the United States of America have been blasted with Arctic Storms, bringing destruction, transportation chaos and claiming over 60 lives so far.
 We pray that those involved in the rescue and recovery process will be strengthened and sustained in the freezing conditions.
- A wave of Russian missile strikes has targeted cities across Ukraine in one of the most extensive bombardments since the war began in Kyiv, Kharkiv, Odesa, Lviv and Zhytomyr. The cities' infrastructure is slowly destroyed as temperatures plummet deeper into the minuses. We remember those left behind in the crossfire with no choice where to go.
- The number of people sentenced to death or charged with capital offences in connection with the ongoing protests in Iran is growing daily. May God have mercy on those making these decisions so they may see how wrong this is.

- After being kept apart for more than 18 months due to war, families in Ethiopia's northern Tigray region are reunited with family members following the resumption of commercial flights into the area from the capital Addis Ababa. God bless this time and continue to rebuild what has been broken down.
- The number of Covid infections in Hong Kong continues to remain high. Let us all do our best to maintain our Covid regime and look out for the needs of those around us. May God comfort those who have lost loved ones and bring peace to their troubled hearts.
- Let us pray for our primary school children as they prepare to return to wholeday face-to-face school after the Lunar New Year break. May the Lord's hand of protection be on them.
