Concerns of the Church

God does nothing except in response to believing prayer. – John Wesley

- A severe heatwave gripping Europe is causing havoc as wildfires rage in several locations claiming lives and destroying all in the blaze's path. Evacuation orders have been issued in several areas of Greece, both the mainland and the islands. We pray all in danger will heed the warnings issued and seek places of safety, and may the hand of the Lord quell the flames.
- In an attempt to swell the numbers of soldiers at the Ukraine front, Russia has raised the age at which men can be conscripted from 27 to 30 years old and extended the age of eligible reservists call up to 55. Many have already refused to join the forces, seeking asylum in neighbouring countries. We must continue to pray for peace in our world wherever that may be needed.
- Soldiers have claimed to have overthrown Niger's government following an apparent coup, detaining President Mohamed Bazoum and establishing curfews and border closures. This is after a long period of dissatisfaction with the system. We pray this takeover will continue to be controlled and peaceful, respecting all peoples of the land.
- Myanmar's ousted civilian leader Aung San Suu Kyi was moved to house arrest after the military detained her following a coup in February 2021. There are mixed feelings towards this move by the authorities, some positive and some hopeful that this be a recognition of the people's wishes. Others speculate that Ms Suu Kyi is not in good health. Let us pray for the people's leader that she will be strengthened to continue leading the country's people in their struggle for democracy.
- The HK Polytechnic University and the charitable organisation Food Angel jointly launched a pilot programme to monitor the health of 100 elderly people living in Sham Shui Po. Members from Food Angel will be trained in basic triage procedures and will monitor progress while delivering the daily lunch boxes. This is such a simple but vital service needed to serve the senior members of our communities. May God bless this programme and encourage more agencies to be involved.
