Please remember as you pray...

- Give thanks to God as three more missionaries have been released by kidnappers in Haiti and are safe. As of today, 5 of the 17 kidnapped have been released. We pray for the safety of the others.
- Consider those countries standing against the violation of Human Rights in China. The United Kingdom, Canada, USA and Australia have announced a diplomatic boycott of the Beijing Winter Olympics, set for February 2022.
- Pray for a better system of sharing Covid Vaccines through the COVAX scheme as many developing countries are not able to use the vaccine that they are given due to the short shelf life of the vaccines. Many have gone unused due to this factor and benefit no one.
- We pray for the safety of Aid workers and those they are serving in Northern Ethiopia. Gunmen have held aid workers at gun point as they looted supplies of essential food donated through the World Food Programme. The action of the gunmen has not only endangered the lives of the workers but also suspended further food aid to the area.
- Pray for the people and for peace in Myanmar as yet another horrific military attack has been executed in a number of villages in Central Myanmar, killing 13 people and destroying all in their path.
- Remember the people and the communities living in the shadow of Mount Semeru, after the eruption of last week the volcano continues to throw out more ash forcing rescuers to suspend the search for survivors.
- In a new report shared by Reporters Without Borders, China has been named as the 'world's biggest captor of journalists'. Currently the number of reporters being detained is at least 127.
- Remember, Jimmy Lai, Gwyneth Ho and Chow Hang Tung who have been found guilty in court, charged with unlawful assembly. The three were found to have participated in an unauthorised Tiananmen vigil.
- As temperatures continue drop in our city pray for those who do not have adequate shelter or means to keep warm, those on the streets, those struggling to pay household bills, many looking for work.


