For the World and Hong Kong

- We remember the people in Myanmar. May God bless the civilians especially those who have taken courage to seek for people's rights and stand against the military's abusive use of power. We pray that God protects the innocent. May His justice reign and drive the wicked away. Pray to the God of Liberty to set his people free from tyranny.
- At least 27 students were abducted Wednesday when armed men raided a state-run school in Niger State, north-west Nigeria, according to the report from CNN. The number of missing teachers is unknown. Pray that the students and teachers will be found and safely rescued as soon as possible. Remember the country and pray for good protection for all people especially the children.
- Remember the people in Catalonia, Spain. May the voice of the people be heard and their basic civil rights be upheld by the government. May peace and justice reign in the country.
- We are pleased to see the number of confirmed COVID cases dropping. Pray for the resilience of the people in the community. The HK government has announced that massive vaccinations will be ready by next week. We pray that those who are more at risk to the virus will be given priority and the side effects will be kept minimal.

May the government address to the problem by setting up the Unemployment Fund as suggested by the Trade Unions and social services agencies working with grassroots communities.
