Please remember as you pray...

- We continue to pray for the Covid situation in Hong Kong as the numbers have risen to over 2000 cases daily. However, while the numbers are growing steadily, officials have noted that there has not been a sudden surge in cases.
- Authorities are considering designating specific hospitals to treat positive Covid cases in preparation should there be another surge.
- Less than a week after we celebrated refugees in our community, our newspapers shared the horrific news from Europe and the United States of America. In Europe, officials openly attacked a group of refugees striving to reach the Melilla enclave on the Morrocan-Spanish border. In the USA Migrant Smuggling has claimed the lives of 53 people. May God heal the wounds of the injured and comfort those who have lost loved ones. May the Lord protect us all from those who would profit from the lives of others.
- On Wednesday, NATO agreed to put over 300,000 troops at high readiness from 2023. This is a massive increase from the 40,000 soldiers previously placed on high alert. This new military line-up is designed to counter better Russia, the country the alliance has designated as posing the most significant threat. The new approach resembles how NATO forces organised their forces during the Cold War. We pray the need for these troops to be deployed will never happen.
- We pray for the success and continued commitment of the Kenyan government in their plans to build safe houses in Saudi Arabia for migrant workers who are abuse victims. May other countries see the promise and property of such action for their citizens working overseas.
- Ferdinand Marcos Junior has been sworn in as President of the Philippines, with Sara Duterte, the daughter of the outgoing president, sworn in as the vice president. May they govern wisely and heed the cries of the people.

• 1 July was the 25th anniversary of the establishment of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region and the inauguration of the incoming John Lee administration. May the voices of the people be heard and served.
